

COCURRICULAR ELIGIBILITY

The Intramural athletic program, chorus program, and Computer Club at Dr. Levesque School are cocurricular programs and as such are extensions of the regular program of studies.

To ensure that every student who is involved in the Dr. Levesque School cocurricular programs maintains a level of performance appropriate to his/her ability in his/her classroom work, the following policy is written:

1. When a student is not performing within his/her capabilities, i.e., homework assignments, participation, study work, and test grades, a conference will be held between the classroom teacher and cocurricular instructor and a warning will be given to the student. If performance continues to be below par, a second conference will be held to determine if the student will be suspended from the activity until his/her performance has improved to the satisfaction of the classroom teacher.
2. When a student is given a warning/suspension from the activity, his/her parents and the office will be notified by the classroom teacher of the fact and of the reasons for the action taken.
3. Reinstatement - any student who has been taken out of the cocurricular program may be reinstated at the discretion of the classroom teacher when the student's performance is up to his/her capabilities.
